## Elmora Youth League - Ethics Committee: *Policy Guideline 1.0*THE FUNDAMENTALS OF SPORTSMANSHIP

## GAIN AN UNDERSTANDING AND APPRECIATION FOR THE RULES OF THE CONTEST.

Know the rules. If you are uninformed, refrain from expressing opinions on officials or coaches. The spirit of GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP depends on conformance to a rule's intent as well as to the letter of a given rule.

#### EXERCISE REPRESENTATIVE BEHAVIOR AT ALL TIMES.

The true value of Little League competition relies upon everyone exhibiting behavior which is representative of a sound value base. Your behavior influences others whether you are aware of it or not.

## RECOGNIZE AND APPRECIATE SKILLED PERFORMANCES REGARDLESS OF AFFILIATION.

Applause for an opponent's good performance displays generosity and is a courtesy that should be regularly practiced. This not only represents GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP but also reflects a true awareness of the game by recognizing and acknowledging quality.

#### **EXHIBIT RESPECT FOR THE OFFICIALS**

Officials of any contest are impartial arbitrators who are trained and who perform to the best of their ability. Mistakes by all those involved in the contests are a part of the game. The rule of GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP is to accept and abide by the decisions made by the umpire. This is critical for young athletes to learn for later applications in life.

## DISPLAY OPENLY A RESPECT FOR THE OPPONENT AT ALL TIMES.

Opponents should be treated cordially and accorded tolerance at all times. Be a positive representative for your team and family. This fundamental is the Golden Rule in action.

## DISPLAY A PRIDE IN YOUR ACTIONS AT EVERY OPPORTUNITY.

Never allow your ego to interfere with good judgment and your responsibility as a League representative. Regardless of whether you are an adult, player, coach, or official, this value is paramount since it suggests that you care about yourself and how others perceive you.

# Elmora Youth League - Ethics Committee: *Policy Guideline 1.0*CONDUCT GUIDELINES AND BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

#### THE COACHES

- Exemplify the highest moral character, behavior and leadership, adhering to strong ethical and integrity standards. Practicing good citizenship is practicing good sportsmanship!
- Respect the integrity and personality of the individual athlete.
- Abide by and teach the rules of the game in letter and in spirit.
- Set a good example for players and spectators to follow--please refrain from arguments in front of players and spectators; no gestures which indicate an official or opposing coach does not know what he or she is doing or talking about; no throwing of any object in disgust. Shake hands with the officials and opposing coaches before and after the contest in full view of the public.
- Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials. The officials are
  doing their best to help promote athletics. Treating them with respect,
  even if you disagree with their judgment will only make a positive
  impression of you and your team in the eyes of all people at the event.
- Display modesty in victory and graciousness in defeat.
- Instruct participants and spectators in proper sportsmanship responsibilities and demand that they make sportsmanship the No. 1 priority.
- Develop a program that rewards participants and spectators for displaying proper sportsmanship and enforces penalties on those who do not abide by sportsmanship standards.
- Be no party to the use of profanity, obscene language or improper actions.

#### THE ATHLETES

- Accept and understand the seriousness of your responsibility, and the privilege of representing your league and the community.
- Live up to the standards of sportsmanship established by the league and the coaching staff.
- Learn the rules of the game thoroughly and discuss them with parents, fans, and other players. This will assist both them and you in the achievement of a better understanding and appreciation of the game.

### Elmora Youth League - Ethics Committee: Policy Guideline 1.0

#### THE ATHLETES (Continued)

- Treat opponents the way you would like to be treated, as a guest or friend. Who better than yourselves can understand all the hard work and team effort that is required of your sport?
- Wish opponents good luck before the game and congratulate them in a courteous manner following either victory or defeat.
- Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials. The officials are doing their best to help promote you and your sport. Treating them with respect, even if you disagree with their judgment, will only make a positive impression of you and your team in the eyes of the officials and all the people at the event.

#### **SPECTATORS**

- Remember that you are at the contest to support and yell for your team and to enjoy the skill and competition, not to intimidate or ridicule the other team or its fans.
- Remember that baseball is a learning experience for young athletes and that mistakes are sometimes made. Praise athletes in their attempt to improve themselves as athletes and as people as you would praise a student working in the classroom.
- Learn the rules of the game, so that you may understand and appreciate why certain situations take place.
- Show respect for the opposing players, coaches and spectators. Treat them as you would treat a guest in your own home.
- Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials. Understand that
  they are doing their best to help promote the athlete, and admire their
  willingness to participate in full view of the public.
- Recognize and show appreciation for an outstanding play by either team
- Refrain from the use of any controlled substances (alcohol, drugs, etc.) before, during and after the game on or near the site of the event (i.e. tailgating).
- Use only cheers that support and uplift the teams involved.
- Be a positive role model at events through your own actions and by censuring those around you whose behavior is unbecoming.

#### Elmora Youth League - Zero Tolerance Policy

Pursuant to action taken by the Ethics Committee as resolved by the Elmora Youth League Executive Board on April 18, 2001, the following penalties and procedures are instituted:

- 1. Any manager, coach or player who is ejected from a game is immediately suspended from the following scheduled game. The offending party is further directed to appear before the Ethics Committee within 48 hours and explain his or her conduct. At that time additional penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the Ethics Committee.
- 2. Any manager, coach or player accused in written form of gross misconduct may be suspended from all baseball/softball/basketball activities. This suspension would continue throughout the investigation process. Upon written report of gross misconduct, the Ethics Committee shall convene within 48 hours to investigate the complaint. The Ethics Committee shall forward their findings to the Executive Board within 24 hours of their meeting. At no time shall 72 hours pass between receipt of the written complaint and action by the Executive Board if at all possible.
- 3. Depending on the nature of the misconduct, the Ethics Committee may recommend suitable punishment up to a suspension for a full season or a lifetime ban subject to repeat offenses.
- **4.** Any spectator accused in written form of gross misconduct may be subject to the above investigation process. Depending on the nature of the misconduct, the Ethics Committee may recommend suitable punishment up to a suspension for a full season or a lifetime ban subject to repeat offenses at all EYL sanctioned activity within the Thomas J. Hanratty Complex or any other EYL sanctioned sport or activity.

### **Manager and Coach Responsibilities**

- 1. **To attend Coaches Meetings** conducted by your division coordinator.
- 2. **To conduct at least 2 practices per week**. Arrange your practice schedule with your coaching partners. Usually, most teams practice once on weekends and once during the week. The times and days are up to you. Field 6, 7 and 10 may be available to EYL coaches for practice, whenever there is no EYL game scheduled. Contact <a href="Schedule@ElmoraYouth.com">Schedule@ElmoraYouth.com</a> for a copy of the UC field permit.
- 3. To Report all injuries to the Safety Officer and Insurance Coordinator. All injuries and/or accidents during games or practices must be reported to the Safety Officer (Mark Weis 908 337-6105) within 48 hours. Injuries, which may seem minor at the time, may develop into something major. Play it safe and report the injury. See page 3 for details.
- 4. To have Team at Field on Time Coaches and players are expected at the field for a game 30 minutes prior to scheduled game time, rain or shine. RAIN OUTS CAN ONLY BE CALLED AT THE FIELD AT GAME TIME BY THE COACHES OF BOTH TEAMS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE BOARD MEMBER ON DUTY. If a hard rain cancels the entire day's games, your division coordinator will contact the team manager.
- 5. To Prepare for Games
  - a. Make Chalk batters box and foul lines If Necessary
  - b. Complete line-up card with starting pitcher name circled, and present it to home plate umpire.
  - c. Assign parent or players to operate scoreboard
- 6. To keep players in dugout during the game Players are to leave the dugouts only to visit the bathroom and to play the game. Players should be reminded to visit the bathroom prior to game to eliminate visits during game. No visits to the refreshment stand are allowed. Players and/or Coaches should supply their own water. Players outside of dugouts are subject to injury from hit or thrown balls. In addition, family or friends are not allowed to visit players on the field or in the dugout.
- 7. After the game, (1) Rake the Field after the game; (2) Return all equipment to the field shed (Rakes, Scoreboard keypads, shovels) All dirt areas must be raked smooth after every game by all coaches, win or lose. Caution: Never rake the dirt (clay) onto the grass areas. The mixture of infield dirt will kill the grass.
- 8. **To clean up the dugout after each game** Be sure all your player's belongings are accounted for, and with their help, pick up the area.
- 9. **To Return Equipment to Division Coordinator** at the end of the season.

### **Parents Responsibilities**

- 1. Let your child choose to play Little League and to quit if he or she does not enjoy baseball. Encourage participation, but don't pressure.
- 2. Understand what your child wants from participating in Little League and provide a supportive atmosphere for achieving these goals.
- 3. Set limits on your child's participation in baseball. You need to determine when she or he is physically and emotionally ready to play and to insure that the conditions for playing are safe.
- 4. Make certain your child's coach is qualified to guide your child through the Little League experience.
- 5. Keep winning in perspective by remembering Athletics First, Winning Second. Instill this perspective in your child.
- 6. Help your child set realistic goals about his or her own performance so success is guaranteed.
- 7. Help your child understand the experiences associated with competitive sports so she or he can learn the valuable lesson sports can teach.
- 8. Discipline your child when he or she misbehaves, breaks the rules, or is uncooperative or uncontrollable.
- 9. Turn your child over to the coach at practices and games, and avoid meddling or becoming a nuisance.
- 10. To notify your team's manager when your child cannot attend a game or practice. It is a good idea to give your manager at least 48 hours notice when you expect to miss a game.

#### Insurance

**Damage to Cars:** All spectators park their cars at their own risk! This applies to the Hanratty Complex as well as in Warinanco Park. If a vehicle is struck by a baseball or softball, it is <u>not</u> covered by EYL insurance.

Accidents and Injuries - All managers should have a copy of an insurance accident report form in their medical box. Additional forms will be available at the Hanratty Complex field house. Injuries must be reported immediately to the team manager and a report filed, and sent to Bob Griffith, Insurance Coordinator. He will review the incident and submit the claim form to EYL's insurance provider (Bollinger Insurance). All claims must also be submitted to the family's primary insurance company. EYL's insurance is a secondary insurance on the claim.

### **Baseball & Softball Safety**

To help your child avoid injuries while playing baseball or softball, follow these safety tips from the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Consumer Product Safety Commission, and other sports and health organizations. (Note: These tips apply to adult ball players, too.)

#### Tips for Preventing Baseball and Softball Injuries

- 1. Before your child starts a training program or plays competitive baseball or softball, take him or her to the doctor for a physical exam. The doctor can help assess any special injury risks your child may have.
- 2. Make sure your child wears all the required safety gear every time he or she plays and practices. Insist that your child wear a helmet when batting, waiting to bat, or running the bases. Helmets should have eye protectors, either safety goggles or face guards. Shoes with molded cleats are recommended (most youth leagues prohibit the use of steel spikes). If your child is a catcher, he or she will need additional safety gear: catcher's mitt, face mask, throat guard, long-model chest protector, and shin guards.
- 3. If your child is a pitcher, make sure pitching time is limited. Little League mandates time limits and requires rest periods for young pitchers.
- 4. Insist that your child warm up and stretch before playing.
- 5. Teach your child *not* to play through pain. If your child gets injured, see your doctor. Follow all the doctor's orders for recovery, and get the doctor's OK before your child returns to play.
- 6. Make sure first aid is available at all games and practices.
- 7. Talk to and watch your child's coach. Coaches should enforce all the rules of the game, encourage safe play, and understand the special injury risks that young players face. Make sure your child's coach teaches players how to avoid injury when sliding (prohibits headfirst sliding in young players), pitching, or dodging a ball pitched directly at them.
- 8. Above all, keep baseball and softball fun. Putting too much focus on winning can make your child push too hard and risk injury.

#### **Elmora Youth Little League Local Rules**

#### **General Rules**

We will be following the "2018 Official Regulations and Playing Rules" established by Little League for baseball and softball. Each manager has received a copy of the rulebook. If a manager needs a copy of the rulebook, please contact your division coordinator.

Please note that no other rules exist; the rule must appear in the abovementioned rulebooks or on these pages of the EYL League Book.

- 1) The six divisions of 2018 EYL Baseball are:
  - a) 7 teams Tee Ball for players league age 4 to 5
  - b) 7 teams Pioneer for players league age 6 to 7
  - c) 4 teams Rookie for players league age 7 to 9
  - d) 6 teams Minors for players league age 8 to 11
  - e) 8 teams Majors for players league age 10 to 12
  - f) 3 teams Juniors for players league age 13 to 15
- 2) The four divisions of 2018 EYL Softball are:
  - a) 2 teams Teeners softball for players in grades K to 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - b) 3 teams Ponytails softball for players in grades 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup>
  - c) 4 teams Senior softball for players in grades 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>
- 3) Each team must have at least 1 Manager, 2 Coaches and 1 team mother. A team may have up to 3 coaches and 2 team mothers. Please note that PARENTS are not allowed to be on the field or in the dugout. All coaches must be certified to be on the field by our background check process.
  - a) Each rookie, minors and majors team must appoint a coach as the team record keeper. That person is responsible for reporting pitch counts to the league. See rule 23 a.
  - b) Given the age of the players, High School Softball and Junior baseball teams may have one named coach.
  - c) Number of Coaches in Dugout There is a maximum of four (4) coaches allowed in the dugout with the players. (1-Manager, 2-Coaches and 1-Scorekeeper). All managers and coaches must be in their EYL coach shirt during the game. Managers and Coaches are not allowed to wear player uniform jerseys while performing the role of Little League Coach.

If a team has an excess of volunteers, a trade should be made to move players of potential coaches and team moms to teams that are shorthanded.

4) Per Little League rules, the **EYL President appoints all managers** with approval of the EYL Executive Board.

- 5) The draft for the major league baseball, ponytails softball and senior softball will be based on the combined regular season and playoff record. The teams will select players from the candidate pool in the same order for each and every round. Unless traded, the eligible returning players will remain on their team from the prior year.
- 6) **The draft** for the minor and rookie division will use Little League rule "Method in First Year of Operation Plan A" for the draft.
- 7) All players age 10 and older **must attend the 10-11-12 year old rating** to participate in any level of Elmora Youth League. Failure to attend the tryouts may result in termination from the league for the player. Players age 9 have the option to attend this level.
- 8) All 11 and 12 year old baseball players will be drafted into the major league. A parent, wishing to have their 11 or 12 year old play minors, need to file for a Little League exemption. Please see the Major League coordinator.
- 9) Major League Baseball Vacancies: All major league teams will maintain a roster of 12 players. When a vacancy occurs because of injury or withdrawal from the league, the Team Manager must select a 10, 11 or 12 year old baseball player from the minor league. This is not an option. If the manager does not select a player, then the EYL Executive Board is required to place a player on the Major League Team. Minor League managers must understand that placement on a Major League team is the objective of Little League Baseball and they should work with the league to accomplish this goal for the player.
  - a) No player will be called up from the Minor League to a Major League team in the last two weeks of the regular season. (See Little League regulation III (d)2)
- 10) **Player Draft:** The Ratings and Draft for each of our divisions are run by the team managers. Once a player is selected by a manager, they are required to play for the team. Unless the player is traded.
- 11) Player Trades: Player may be traded to another team within their division. The particulars of the trade must be decided by the two team managers and all Little League rules apply with regards to trading.
  - a) The division coordinator will review all trades and present them to the EYL Executive board for approval.

- b) Per Little League Rules: The division coordinator must monitor any attempts by managers and parents to manipulate the system and thus create an imbalance in the league. ALL TRADES MUST BE FOR JUSTIFIABLE REASONS AND BE APPROVED BY THE EYL EXECUTIVE BOARD
- 12) **Protests** The team manager must issue the protest immediately to the plate umpire.
  - a) Only the team manager may address the umpire regarding a call made on the field.
  - b) If the assistant coaches (named as coach in the league book) address the umpire, they may be ejected from the game and face possible suspension or dismissal from the league.
- 13) **Dismissal of Player:** Any player who is out of the lineup for more than three consecutive weeks (or six games.) is subject to being removed from his/her team by action of the board of directors. However, the board of directors reserves the right to allow such player to remain on the roster. Managers must make the division coordinator aware if any player missed more than two consecutive games for any reason. Failure to do so will be cause for corrective action against the manager. (See LL regulation III (d))
- 14) **Playoffs** At the end of the season, the EYL Executive Board will determine if there will be playoffs for each division. The playoffs may be single or double elimination.
  - There is no time limit on playoff games. The EYL Scheduler will try to schedule each playoff game to insure all games are played to completion.
- 15) **Temporary player call ups** If the manager knows they will be short players for a game, they are allowed to bring up a player or players from the lower division.
  - a) If a manager brings up a player and there are adequate team players to field a team, then the called up player may only play the minimum number of innings. Three innings in Minors, Majors and Ponytails. Four innings in Middle School Softball.
  - b) If there is an injury or player needs to leave early, then the rule 15 a) is no longer in effect. Please remember that a manager who constantly brings up unneeded players is affecting the playing time of their team members.

- c) Called up players may not pitch in either baseball or softball.
- d) Only minor league players that are age 10, 11 or 12 may be used as a substitute in the major league. Nine year olds may not play in any Major League baseball game. Eligible players are noted on the minor league team pages.
  - Using a nine-year-old in a major league game is an automatic forfeit for the team that violates the rule.
  - ii) The Manager of the team is also suspended from managing the next game.
- e) Only Rookie players aged 8 and 9 are allowed to play in a Minors Game. Eligible players are noted in the league book
- f) Pioneer players are not allowed to play in a Rookie Game.
- 16) Uniforms All players must be in complete uniform. The complete baseball uniform is the EYLL team jersey, any baseball cap, white baseball pants and the Little League patch on left sleeve. For softball, the uniform is the EYLL team jersey, a visor, black pants and the Little League patch on the left sleeve.
- 17) **Minimum players to start a game** A team must have at least 8 players for baseball and at least 7 players for softball to start and end a game. (This rule does not apply to Majors.) There will be 10-minute grace period before that game is cancelled.
  - a) Major League Baseball must have 9 players to start and they may finish with 8 players. The missing 9<sup>th</sup> position is counted as an out.
  - b) **Automatic Outs** There will an automatic out given to a baseball team that is short of 9 players in the 9th batting position. This rule does not apply to softball.
- 18) All players must bat in the lineup.
  - a) If a player leaves early or leaves the field of play due to sickness or injury, the position is skipped and no out is awarded, as long as the team maintains a minimum of 9 players.
    - i) This rule does not apply to softball.
  - b) If any player arrives late to a game, they are added to the bottom of the batting order. Please see Little League Rule 4.01d. This includes suspended games. Therefore, in a continued game, the batting order may not change and new players are placed at the end of the batting order.

- c) All players must play at least half the game in the field. (E.g. 3 innings in a 6-inning game.) Players may not sit 2 consecutive defensive innings unless for disciplinary or physical reasons.
- 19) Please see Little League rule on page 81. The batter must have both feet in the batter's box.
- 20) Postponements Game postponements are discouraged and they may not be granted. If a team lacks players they must draw from the lower division to field enough players to form a team for a scheduled game.
  - a) If a team cannot play due to lack of players, the game may be forfeited, per action of the EYL Executive Board.
  - b) The Manager must give enough notice (6 days) to the schedule maker to insure a replacement game can be scheduled in the open slot.

Managers are strongly encouraged to make sure they have enough players for each scheduled game and to take appropriate action to call up lower level players if necessary. The objective is to finish the season on time without unnecessary delay.

21) **Free substitutions** at all positions except pitcher in baseball. In softball, a team may substitute the pitcher as long as the pitcher remains on the field. Reminder, any part of an inning pitched is a full inning.

#### 22) Safety Rules

- a) Flinging the Bat If a player flings the Bats. The entire team is warned. The next time a player on the team flings or throws the bat. The player is out and all base runners must return to the original base.
- b) **Avoiding Contact** If there is a play being made at 2<sup>nd</sup> base, 3rd base or home plate, the player must slide or avoid contact. Intentional contact in which, in the umpire's judgment, the runner made no effort to surrender or to avoid contact will be called out.
- c) **Mandatory Facemasks** Facemasks on helmets are mandatory for all levels of Elmora Youth League.
- 23) **Curfews -** For night games there will be a curfew. No new inning may start after the curfew time of 10:00 pm on non-school nights and 9:45 pm on school nights.

- a) The new inning begins as soon as the last out is recorded in the bottom of an inning.
- b) For Middle School Softball, the curfew is 10:00 pm on school nights.

#### 24) Time Limits

- a) Tee Ball 1 hour, 30 minutes
- b) Pioneer Baseball 2 hours.
- c) Teener Softball 1 hour, 30 minutes
- d) Ponytails and Middle School Softball 2 hours
- e) **For all divisions,** the game ends 10 minutes prior to the start time of the next scheduled game. This rule supersedes the above published time limits.
  - i) If the visiting team takes the lead in the top half of the last inning in a shortened game (due to time limit or next scheduled game), the score reverts to the previous complete inning.
  - ii) Any game, which ends due to a time limit or darkness, is an official game no matter how many or how few innings have been played (and no matter who is batting or what the score). This does not include Majors baseball.
  - iii) If a game is shortened by weather, then it is official if 4 innings are completed, 3 ½ if the home team is leading at the bottom of the fourth
    - (1) In Senior Softball, the game is official if 4 innings are completed, 4 ½ if the home team is leading in the bottom of the fifth.
  - iv) A scheduled practice does **not** take priority over a game. The team must wait for the game to complete.
  - v) For Rookie and Minor league games that are scheduled into a two hour time slot, the following rule applies.
    - (1) These games are played with a "drop dead" rule after 1 hour, 50 minutes from the scheduled start of the game (not the actual start time). In these games, the score does not revert to the previous inning if the visitor takes the lead in the top of the inning.
      - Example The 5<sup>th</sup> inning begins with 12 minutes of playing time left in the game and the visitors take the lead in the top of the 5<sup>th</sup> inning.

- Once the one hour, 50 minute limit is reached, the game ends at the drop dead time and the visitors win.
- (2) A new inning may not start with 10 minutes or less of playing time. (The new inning begins as soon as the last out is recorded in the bottom of an inning.)

All team managers are encouraged to start games on time and to keep games moving between innings. Please make sure your catchers are dressed and ready to go whenever your team is taking the field for defensive.

The purpose of this rule is to play as many games as possible on the Hanratty fields. Let's work together for the enjoinment of all families.

#### 25) Practice Fields

- a) Warinanco Park Elmora Youth League holds permits for fields 6, 7 and 10 for specific dates and times. The league does not reserve fields for practice and the coaches may use open fields on a first come, first served basis. An EYL scheduled games take priority over practice.
  - i) If you arrive at a field and find a non-EYL team using the field, please show them a copy of our field permit to use the field. If there is an issue, please contact the UC Police Department at 908 654-9800.
- b) Hanratty Fields Open slots on the Westfield Ave fields are scheduled by the EYL Scheduler.
  - i) Major league baseball teams using Field A may not conduct player batting practice on the smaller field. Also, Major League pitchers cannot pitch live batting to major league hitters. Teams may schedule field "A" for infield, defensive work only.

#### 26) Pitching Rules for Baseball

- a) Pitchers who hit batters are not automatically removed from the mound. (Please see little league rules.)
- b) Curve balls are prohibited in the Rookie, Minors and Majors league divisions of baseball.
- c) Innings Limits
  - i) Rookies: A pitcher may only pitch a single inning. Any part of an inning is considered a full inning. (ie: If a pitcher is brought in to pitch the final 1/3 of an inning, the pitcher may not continue to pitch in the next inning)

- ii) Minor and Major League Division: A pitcher may only pitch 3 consecutive innings per game. See Major League rules on page 21 for exceptions to this rule.
- iii) A single pitch delivered in an inning is considered an inning pitched.
- iv) Any baseball pitcher in any level is limited to six innings per week.
- d) Pitch Counts The team scorekeeper must report name of pitcher, # of innings and # of pitches for each pitcher used in a game to the division coordinator. Please use the pre-printed forms at the Hanratty Fields. Completed pitch counts are placed in the top rack.
- e) The rest days are determined by pitch count.
  - If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed.
  - If a player pitches 51 65 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed.
  - If a player pitches 36 50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
  - If a player pitches 21 35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar day of rest must be observed.
  - If a player pitches 1-20 pitches in a day, no calendar day of rest is required before pitching again.
- 27) **Suspended Games** All Suspended games are continued from the exact point of suspension. They are not replayed from the beginning. All rest requirements for pitchers are enforced. If the pitcher **does not** have the necessary rest, he/she may **not** continue pitching in a continued game. (Little League Rule 4.10d)
- 28) **Volunteer Application Forms** All team managers; coaches and scorekeepers are required to complete the Little League Volunteer Application form. An individual is not allowed on the playing or practice field until the background check is complete.
- 29) **Trophies** It is the policy of Elmora Youth League to award only **one trophy per player** for the spring season. *Teams that win both the playoff and season championships will receive one trophy.*

- a) If a team wins both the regular season and the playoffs, each player will receive **one** trophy that will state "Champions".
- b) Depending on the size of the division, the league may award a 2<sup>nd</sup> place season and/or a 2<sup>nd</sup> place playoff trophy to other teams in the division. No team or player will receive more than one trophy.
- c) Players who do not receive a place trophy will receive a participation award.
- 30) Mercy rule see Little League rule 4.10 (e) for baseball.
  - a) The Ponytails softball division will have a 15 run rule after 4 innings.
  - b) The Senior Softball division will have a 10 run rule after 5 innings.
- 31) Regular season end-dates. The regular season end date for Rookie, Minors and Majors baseball will be approximately May 20. It is our policy to schedule rainouts as soon as possible on the next available field.
- 32) **Playoff Seeding** Seeding for the Minors, Majors, Ponytails and Senior Softball divisions will be.
  - 1 Best win percentage (not necessarily most wins)
  - 2 Head to Head
  - 3 Runs Allowed
  - 4 Coin flip
- 33) Parent Bond and Kitchen Duty EYL is a volunteer run organization and every parent is required to support the league by volunteering.
  - a) The league charges one parent participation bond of \$50 per family. If the bond was not refunded in the prior season, the parent is charged a \$100 bond for the season. The bond is refunded by the end of the year.
  - b) In order to qualify for a refund, a parent must perform the following duties
    - i) Work the kitchen up to three (3) times (if needed) during the spring season, or
    - ii) Perform the duty of Team Manager, or
    - iii) Sponsor a team, or
    - iv) Member of the EYL Executive Board

- c) All other coaches and team mothers are expected to complete the needed kitchen duties.
  - i) If the team mother has 100% coverage for the season, then they may be exempted from kitchen duty. If a parent fails to perform their scheduled field duty, then the team mom is expected to cover in the kitchen.
- d) Only one parent per team is required to work the kitchen for each Hanratty or Sissleman game.

Our experience has shown that the younger teams are well attended by the parents; therefore 1 or 2 turns would cover the kitchen for the entire season. The older levels, we find that many parents are not working the kitchen and the workload falls to a smaller population of parents. Parents of Major League and Senior Softball players may need to work the kitchen 3 times.

- 34) **Use of Illegal Bats** For baseball divisions, all bats must be certified by USA Baseball to be a legal in an EYLL game. The following are the penalties for the team for using an illegal bat in a game.
  - The batter is out and all base runners are returned to their original base.
  - b) The manager is ejected from the game.
  - c) The manager is suspended from the next scheduled game.
- 35) These rules are subject to change by vote of the Elmora Youth League Executive Board.

#### T-Ball

- 1) 6 to 7 batters per inning then switch sides.
- 2) All games end in a tie.

#### Pioneer (Instructional Baseball)

- 1) Pitching Rules (When the player is pitching)
  - a) Player gets 5 pitches from the coach, and then the tee is brought out.
- 2) A team may only bat once through the lineup in an inning.
- 3) Base running
  - a) No stealing and no advance on a passed ball.
  - b) There will be no advancement on an overthrow to first or third base. (Please see Little League Official Playing rules, rule 7.05 Note 2 for details).

c) When a batted ball is returned to the infield, advancement stops when the fielder in possession of the ball calls "TIME".

**Suggestion:** Please remember that these are the instructional divisions and to try and rotate your players into different playing positions.

#### **Rookie and Minors**

- 1) If a game is shortened due to a time limit, it is official (see general rules above sections 23 and 24)
  - a) In a shortened game, at the start of the announced final inning, the 3(Rookie) and 5(Minors) run rule will be waived.
- 2) A player may score a run only as the result of a batted ball or being forced home by base on balls or a hit batsman. No stealing home. There is no advancement on an overthrow or error on a steal. (Coaches, please encourage your catchers to make the throw.)

#### **Rookies**

- 1) The first two innings and the last two innings will be coach pitch.
  - Each batter will get 5 pitches to hit the ball. The batter will be out after 3 swinging strikes or at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> pitch.
  - b. A fouled ball on the 5<sup>th</sup> pitch will be given one more opportunity to put the ball in play
- 2) The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> inning will be player pitch. (4 balls and 3 strikes)
- 3) **No stealing home or second base**. The only base that may be stolen is 3<sup>rd</sup> base.
- 4) No Bunting, No Infield Fly Rule,
- 5) A team may only score **3 runs per inning** except for the 6<sup>th</sup> inning, where there is no limit.
- 6) All runs are allowed to score on batted ball in any inning in excess of 3 runs. All runners must stop when the ball is returned to infield. This does not necessarily mean fielded by an infielder. It will be left to the umpires' discretion as to what runners score, once ball is returned to infield. For example, bases loaded, no outs and 4 runs scored, if the batter hits a 3 run double, all three runs will score. (The EYL Executive board

reserves the right to remove this rule if coaches abuse it. For example, bases loaded infield single turns into a bases clearing error fest.)

#### **Minors**

- 1) No stealing home. The only base that may be stolen is 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> base. There is no advancement on an overthrow or error on a steal. (Coaches, please encourage your catchers to make the throw.)
- 2) A team may only score **5 runs per inning** except for the 6<sup>th</sup> inning, where there is no limit.
- 3) All runs are allowed to score on batted ball in any inning in excess of 3 runs. All runners must stop when the ball is returned to infield. This does not necessarily mean fielded by an infielder. It will be left to the umpires' discretion as to what runners score, once ball is returned to infield. For example, bases loaded, no outs and 4 runs scored, if the batter hits a 3 run double, all three runs will score. (The EYL Executive board reserves the right to remove this rule if coaches abuse it. For example, bases loaded infield single turns into a bases clearing error fest.)
- 4) Only a 10, 11 or 12 year old minor league player may be a substitute for a major league team. The player may not pitch in the major league game. He must wear his Minor league uniform to identify himself as such. Minor league players age nine and younger are not allowed to play in Major League games.
- 5) Minor league games are official no matter how many innings are actually played. For standings, the teams are awarded 2 points for a win and 1 point for a tie.

**Suggestion:** Please remember that this is a developmental division. A coach should try to rotate the players into different playing positions.

#### Majors

- 1) Major league teams must have 9 players to start a game.
- 2) **Double Headers:** If a major league team plays a double header then a pitcher may pitch 6 innings for the day. The 3 innings in a game rule still applies, as does the 6 innings in a week rule.
  - a) **Exception** If the double header is the same teams playing both games, then the pitcher is allowed to pitch up to six innings in a

part of the game. The six innings per week rule and all pitch count restrictions apply.

- 3) **Minor League Substitutes to Majors** Only minor league players that are age 10, 11 or 12 may be used as a substitute in the major league. Nine year olds may not play in any Major League game. The player remains on the minor league team. Please note the following:
  - 1. The "called-up" player may not pitch in the game.
  - 2. The "called-up" player must play at least every other inning.
  - 3. If the "called-up" player has a game at the same time, they must play for their regular minor league team.
  - 4. As a courtesy, it is requested that the manager notify the "called-up" player's team manager.

#### 2018 Inter-league Softball Rules

#### **General Rules**

- 1. In case of bad weather, the visiting coach must contact the home team coach to find out game status.
- 2. If a team does not have enough players to field a team they may pull a player up but NEVER pull a player down. In the Ponytail division (3,4,&5th grade) they may pull a player from another team in that division but they cannot pitch. The only time you should pull a player up is to avoid forfeiting the game.
- 3. All teams must roster bat and there are free substitution at all bases except pitcher.
  - a. If a player becomes injured or leaves the game, the spot in the batting order is skipped.
  - b. No player shall sit the bench two consecutive innings.
- 4. Bat Throwing- If a player from a team throws a bat after swinging; his team will be issued a warning. The next batter that throws the bat from that team will be called out.
- 5. When a play is being made at a base, the offensive player must slide or avoid contact. If there is contact, the runner will be called out, no warnings given.
- 6. The individual league board of directors reserves the right to change or adjust any of the above rules and regulations, or add rules or regulations to help ensure the quality of the league and the safety of its participants.
- 7. PLEASE REMEMBER that this league is not only for the girls to learn and play softball, but more importantly, to have FUN!

#### Rules, Combined Union County Recreational Softball, 2018

Rules shall be 2018 USA Softball Rules, with the following modifications:

#### 6th-8th Grade Division

**Running** - May steal any base, including home; but no more than a total of 4 bases per inning;

**Fielding** - 10 fielders, four of whom must be on the outfield grass - or a space behind the baseline equivalent to the outfield grass - at the release of the pitch; **Batting** - Roster batting;

**Number of players** to start, begin play - No lower limit on number of players, no outs taken for missing players; Opposing teams may supply missing fielders, but are not required to

Runs per Inning - 8 runs per inning limit, except declared last inning Pitching - 4 innings per game max, need not be consecutive; 1 pitch = an inning; NFHS rule for pitcher's plate - at least one foot on to begin pitch; Pitchers' plate at 40', unless coaches agree to 43'; cannot change during game; No HBP rule limit, but coaches advised to use common sense

**Run Ahead Rule** - 10 after 5, by agreement, may continue to play (Umpires will be instructed that they must continue game if requested by coaches - any refusal or failure to be reported to commissioner)

**Time Limit** - No new inning, 1 hour 45 minutes, no drop dead **Interference, Obstruction** - Runner must slide to avoid contact at all bases and home plate; Umpires' point of emphasis, defensive obstruction **Courtesy Runners** - Courtesy runners for pitcher, catcher, injured player: last batted out

#### 4th - 5th Grade Division

#### No dropped third strike

No Infield Fly

**Running** - May only steal 3rd base, ball must be crossing plate before runner may leave base; no limit on number of steals per inning

**Fielding** - 10 fielders, four of whom must be on the outfield grass - or a space behind the baseline equivalent to the outfield grass - at the release of the pitch; **Batting** - Roster batting;

**Number of players** to start, begin play - No lower limit on number of players, no outs taken for missing players; Opposing teams may supply missing fielders, but are not required to

Runs per Inning - 5 runs per inning limit, except declared last inning

2018 Rules

**Pitching** - 3 innings per game, need not be consecutive; 1 pitch = an inning; NFHS rule for pitcher's plate - at least one foot on to begin pitch; Pitchers' plate at 35'; No HBP rule limit, but coaches advised to use common sense **Innings** - 6 inning game

Ball - 11" ball

Run Ahead Rule - 15 after 4, 12 after 5, by agreement, may continue to play (Umpires will be instructed that they must continue game if requested by coaches - any refusal or failure to be reported to commissioner)

Time Limit - No new inning, 1 hour 45 minutes, no drop dead

Interference, Obstruction - Runner must slide to avoid contact at all bases and home plate; Umpires' point of emphasis, defensive obstruction

Courtesy Runners - Courtesy runners for pitcher, catcher, injured player: last batted out

#### **Tournament Teams**

Elmora Youth League traditionally sponsors softball and baseball tournament teams that participate in a higher level of competitive play during the summer. The players on these teams may be required to play games on consecutive days, weekends and holidays. Our coaches will run several practices during the summer so that the players develop their skills to a higher level.

All players on EYL Tournament Teams are required to pay a separate registration fee. Only Elmora Youth League registered players are eligible to play on Elmora Youth League Tournament Teams. Our goal is to form the strongest team from each age group in our league. Therefore, a player is bound to play for their appropriate age group.

**Selection of Managers** - The president of the league selects the Managers of the teams with input from the Tournament Director and the appropriate division coordinator(s). The EYL Executive Board approves the selection.

**Player Eligibility** – A player is bound to play for the team of their age group. This is based on league age, not actual age. The manager of the player's age group has all rights to players in their age group and only the manager may release the player to a team in a higher age group. The EYL Executive Board must approve all player movements.

**Selection of Players** - The Manager of the team, along with input from the Executive Board will run an approved process to select the players. All tournament team players must be registered EYL players for the 2018 spring season.

The approved methods of selection are:

- 1) The division managers meet and select the team as a committee, or
- The division managers meet and select the candidates for an invitational tryout, the tournament team manager selects the players.

Or

3) The tournament team manager conducts an open tryout and selects the players. All other methods are illegal and against the direction of the EYL Executive Board. Any tournament team manager that does not follow these guidelines for player selection will be removed from their tournament team duty.

**Uniforms** – The EYL colors are Royal Blue with White or Grey trim. Our teams are formed to represent our league and they must carry our league colors to their tournament games. Exceptions require approval of the EYL President and the Board. The Baseball teams are known as the **Elmora Troopers** and the Softball Teams carry the name **Elmora Thunder**.

Playing Time -\_Tournament team managers are bound only to rules of the tournament with regards to playing time. EYL rules regarding minimum playing time do not apply to tournament teams. For the player selection methods 1) and 2) described above, the following EYL schedule defines which of the divisions managers participate in the process. All Managers must participate irregardless of player eligibility.
